



Themed activity – 'I am your Food Angel'

(Below is the suggested action only. School can adjust the content according to own need.)

Based on the 'Secret Angel' game, this activity will have students matched in pairs – one student being the 'Food Angel' and the other being the 'Master'. Each student is at the same time a 'Food Angel' of one classmate and a 'Master' of another classmate. 'Food Angels' will have to observe their 'Masters' during the activity and encourage the 'Masters' to cherish food from time to time.

Objective: To widely spread the cherish food message among campus through interaction and encouragement between students.

Action period: One day to one week (or even longer)

Action 1-2-3:

1. Using a class as a unit, students are matched into pairs of 'Food Angels' and 'Masters' randomly, by lucky draw or any other method. Each student is at the same time a 'Food Angel' and a 'Master' of another classmate. During the matching process, each student will only know the identity of his/her 'Master', but not that of his/her 'Food Angel'.
2. Each 'Food Angel' has to try his/her best to remind his/her 'Master' to cherish food during the activity. For example, by leaving messages, gifts, etc. Whenever the 'Food Angel' discovers any wasteful behavior of his/her 'Master', he/she should actively remind the 'Master' not to waste any food. During the whole process, the identity of the 'Food Angel' should be kept secret and should not be revealed.
3. During the activity, each 'Food Angel' has to send at least one or two secret messages to his/her 'Master'. The more messages sent to the 'Master' without your identity being known, the higher score you will get.
4. After the activity, each student can make a guess on who his/her 'Food Angel' is.

Make a guess

My 'Food Angel' is _____.

My 'Food Angel' has sent me _____ cherish food message(s) to remind me not to waste food.

5. The teacher will reveal the identity of each 'Food Angel'.





Who will win?

- 'Food Angels' who have sent the most number of cherish food messages without his/her identity being known.

Pre-school version

- Announce that all students have been named 'Food Angel' on the activity day.
- Every single student has two missions:
 - (1) Not to waste any food – finish all the food they order or being given;
 - (2) Whenever they discover any food-wasting behavior of their classmates, encourage the classmates to finish all the food.
