



## 'Cherish Food Corps' Interactive Game

(Below is the suggested guideline only. School can adjust the content according to own need.)

Game materials include:

- Game Guideline
- E-copy of Cherish Food Diary\*
- E-copy of Cherish Tool sticker\*

\*Schools are welcome to print the e-copy

### Introduction:

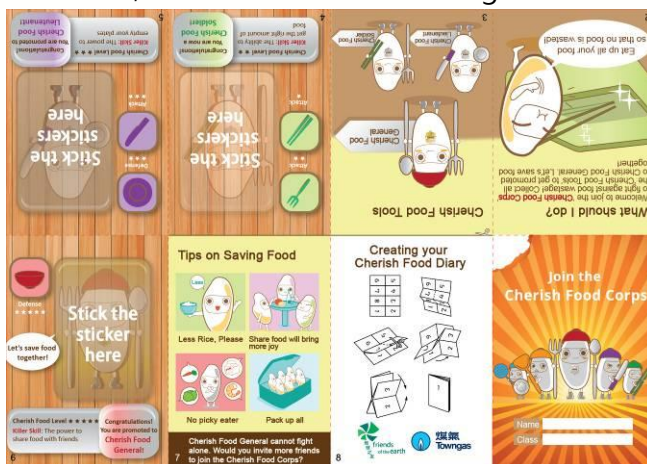
Each student will be given a Cherish Food Diary. Students who are able to finish all food at lunch or tea time will be given a "Cherish Tool" sticker each day. When students successfully collect the whole series of stickers, they will be promoted as "Cherish Food General" and win the game.

**Objective:** To build up an attitude of cherishing food among campus through students' support with actual deeds.

**Action period:** One day to one week (or even longer)

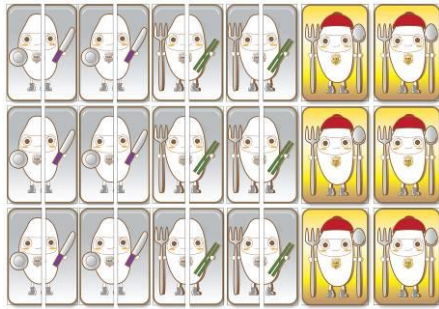
### Action 1-2-3:

1. Schools can print and prepare the diary and stickers according to the number of participating students
2. Each student will be given a Cherish Food Diary to record their cherish food situation in a week, and cross check with neighbors whether each other has finished their food.



3. Students who are able to finish all food at lunch and tea time will be rewarded with a "Cherish Tool" sticker each day. When students gather the required stickers for each corps rank, they can move up to a higher position. Corps ranks are divided into three levels: Cherish Food Soldier (2 pieces of tools), Cherish Food Lieutenant (2 pieces of tools) and Cherish Good General (1 piece of tools).





4. Students who successfully collect the whole series of stickers will be promoted as "Cherish Food General" .
5. After the activity, students can share their Cherish Food Corps position with their friends.

#### **Pre-school version**

- Announce that all students have been named 'Cherish Food Soldier' on the activity day.
- Each student has two missions:
  - (1) Not to waste any food – finish all the food they order or being given;
  - (2) Whenever they discover any food-wasting behavior of their classmates, encourage the classmates to finish all the food.
- As long as students can finish all their food once, they can be promoted to "Cherish Food General" directly and be awarded with a sticker.
